Power Outage

During natural disasters POS systems cannot operate due to outages, but merchants still accept cash. APG has an emergency PoS release system to enable transactions during outages.

Parking meters, vending machines, laundrettes and a babysitter often only take cash. It's estimated that 20 million businesses in Europe do not accept credit cards and some even offer discounts with cash purchases.



Restaurant Tips
